1. The President called the meeting to order at 11:25 a.m.

3. The minutes for February were approved via email.
4. President's Report. Terry noted that the courts appear slightly less crowded since the opening of other pickleball venues in the area.
5. VP's Report. All court permit/event dates requested for this summer through the end of the year are pending, and awaiting approval by TUSD. This weekend, Carl, Bonnie, and Greg will attend the Paddle Demo Day at Mission Viejo Tennis Center to get ideas for our demo event.
6. Treasurer's Report. The organization is in good financial standing. Gerry is reviewing insurance proposals.
7. Items for Discussion.
 - a. Revised events calendar. The August 2nd Round Robin was rescheduled to accommodate another group. If we do not proceed with our paddle demo day on

Saturday July 25th, we will hold the round robin on Sunday July 26th.

- b. Facilities repairs update. Repairs to the fence between Courts 3 and 4 are awaiting materials which are expected to arrive early next week. Instead of repairing, TUSD will be replacing the damaged court benches. All work is expected to complete within a week of receiving materials.
 - c. Member suggestions.
 - i. Memorial Wall. A member suggested we create a Memorial Wall to remember members who have passed. The board recognizes that the courts are not owned by Tustin Pickleball and discussed the difficulty of identifying all who passed, coordinating with next of kin for approval, and sustaining such a memorial year over year. The suggestion was not adopted.
 - ii. Misters for summertime. Another member suggested we install misters such as he'd experienced at courts in Arizona. Installation of misters would require installation of plumbing, a water source and ongoing maintenance. Given these considerations, the suggestion was not adopted.
8. Directors' Updates.
- a. Communications. Bonnie is promoting this Sunday's Round Robin to fill up the Men's 4.0+, Women's 3.5+ and Women's 3.0 divisions.
 - b. Events. Greg has reached out to multiple paddle representatives to gauge interest in participating in a demo day on July 25th. Also, see item 5.
