



Tustin Pickleball BOD Meeting

July 7, 2026

1. The President called the meeting to order at 11:24 a.m.
2. Board members in attendance were:

Carl Cheng, Vice President, was absent.
3. The minutes for May were approved via email and posted to the website.
4. President's Report.
 - a. With the recent opening of other pickleball venues in the area (e.g. Hart Park, Mike Ward Park, Pickleball Haven) we are seeing less over-crowding at the courts.
 - b. TUSD completed the installation of yellow plastic fence toppers on all courts and the fence between Courts 3 and 4 is now fixed. New benches were installed on Courts 1 and 4. Still to be completed – power outlet in the shed, trash can receptacle on court 4. With the summer break, TUSD priorities are on classroom repairs so completion dates for our remaining items is TBD.
5. VP's Report. (Terry reporting for Carl) Carl has submitted requests for court permits through the end of the year. Permits have been approved by TUSD through mid-September.
6. Treasurer's Report. Insurance policies have been purchased to provide the club with additional coverage for liability and property damage. These policies are separate from the venue insurance required by TUSD for court permits.
7. Items for Discussion.
 - a. A decision was made to allow directors, check in desk staff, and drill instructors to comp/waive the daily drop-in fee for friends and family at their discretion. All

comp'd guests will be required to sign the waiver form. To track and avoid potential abuse of privilege, all comps shall be documented on the "Complimentary Items & Services" form located in the check in binder.

- b. Any incident involving violations of our Code of Conduct, Policy of Play or failure to pay membership or drop-in fees shall be documented by the acting director or on-duty desk volunteer in the red log book. Repeated violations could result in disciplinary action including suspension or termination of membership (to be decided by the BOD).
- c. Our annual members appreciation lunch is scheduled for Saturday August 8th. A facilities permit has been approved for extended hours to 3pm and the picnic area by the TUSD parking lot is confirmed for our use. Based on member feedback from last year, lunch will be served earlier this year, starting at 10am.

This year's event will include paddle demos provided by Pickleball First Shop from 8am to 2pm on Court 8. Members will be able to play with demo paddles from different brands and purchase paddles on site at a discount.

Bonnie will check pricing for box lunches from Ike's.

- d. Board members will begin identifying potential candidates for next year's BOD.

8. Directors' Updates.

- a. Communications. Bonnie continues to post on social media about upcoming events, known court closures, and parking issues.
- b. Events. Announcement and registration links for the Rotating Partners Round Robin Event on July 26 went out yesterday. As of today, both men's and women's 3.0 levels are sold out.
- c. Facilities. Jimmy tested a new method for cleaning the expansion joint on Courts 2 and 5 today. He will complete the work in the next week.
- d. Membership is currently at 955.
